The remaining 75% of the grade will be based on quizzes, exams, and special projects.

The French 10 class will culminate in the FLACS Checkpoint B Exam. On the exam students will have the opportunity to demonstrate their proficiency in all skill areas.

This year will be a most exciting one for you. In each lesson, you will have the opportunity to practice previously learned vocabulary and structures as well as to learn new ones. Should you need extra help, please see your teacher.
