As a sequel to Spanish II, this course will continue to enable you to express yourself in the areas of speaking, listening, reading and writing. You will review the basic vocabulary of personal likes, dislikes, leisure activities, foods, shopping and the like and will explore new themes of study such as travel, celebrations, and technology, etc. Throughout our exploration of these themes, we will expand our knowledge of the verb system and general structure of the Spanish language.

Each student's individual performance is vital to the success of this class. Student attendance demonstrates that hard work results in achievement. Students bear a responsibility for their own education, which means a commitment to work.

In the foreign language classroom, the class participation grade counts as **25%** of the total grade and is based on: punctual arrival in class, timely completion of homework assignments, and daily positive participation and contribution in all class activities as described in the *Class Participation Rubrics*. The remaining **75%** of the grade will be based on written quizzes and exams, and special projects.

The Spanish III class will culminate in a comprehensive final exam in June that will count as 1/9 of your final grade.

This year will be a most exciting one for you. In each lesson, your knowledge of Spanish will expand tremendously. We will constantly be practicing previously learned vocabulary and structures while learning new ones. Should you need extra help, please see your teacher.
